

Carbon Farming Outreach Project

The 'Carbon Farming Outreach Project' is a national industry-led program funded by the Australian Government and led by the Grower Group Alliance (GGA). Stirlings to Coast Farmers is a collaborative partner contracted to deliver workshops to farmers throughout the South Coast and lower Great Southern Regions. The content, developed by the University of Melbourne and Prof. Richard Ekhard, is scientific based, independent and aimed to equip local farmers with fundamental knowledge on carbon in farming and how measuring and monitoring carbon emissions may benefit farming businesses.

The SCF workshop series, named 'Confusion to Clarity – science-based, locally relevant workshops on carbon in farming for Great Southern Farmers' has already kicked off with workshops delivered in Green Range and Cranbrook on the 2 & 3 April 2025.
